

Vision


To become a global CSR partner across sectors by designing and implementing innovative & impactful activities that kickstarts a movement of social reform.

Programs / EDUCATION


Navneet Foundation's focus is on education, within the context of a broader social responsibility strategy. It believes in the growth of the nation and empowerment of its citizens. Through digital education programs, scholarships, vocational training, and remedial classes, the Foundation looks towards improving the quality of education in India. Distribution of books, teachers' training programs, and art & culture developmental programs are conducted with an aim to bridge the existing gap between learning and skill development.

Digital Education Program

Navneet Foundation has upgraded the quality of learning through the implementation of the Digital Education Program across 130+ schools in Maharashtra and Gujarat. Over 163 classrooms have been digitalised. Thus, enhancing interest in interactive and participatory learning among 26,684 children across 18 districts.

Vocational Training

To achieve success in the real world, life skills education is a necessity. Navneet Foundation realised this importance, and supported another educational initiative focused on the development of a vocational training institute in Gujarat to



enable students to learn and secure jobs. Navneet Foundation successfully created an environment for learning, thus empowering 30 youth to bag jobs in corporate and private companies.

The Foundation also works with the youth and community to bring about social change. By working alongside implementation partners, vocational training programs for the youth and a learning centre for children was set up in Mumbai. A library with books on various subjects of development, science, and technology was made accessible to one and all. Presently, 40 students have registered for the vocational program.

Remedial Classes

With a goal to improve learning outcomes, Navneet Foundation began remedial education classes for 115 students under trained para-teachers. Of these, 80 children were mainstreamed into formal classes of their school in Village Khaniwade near Navneet factory.

These classes along with an exposure visit to the Navneet factory at Khaniwade helped students catch up with their learnings through creative and participatory teaching methods. Especially since most of the attendees were underprivileged first generation learners unable to cope with their studies at school as they lacked the proper guidance at home.



Distribution of Books & Stationery

As a knowledge-driven organisation, Navneet provided stationery, books, and other learning and educational material to NGOs and underprivileged groups. This year, 7 schools received 14,800 books and 19,600 stationery items from the Foundation.

Additionally, schools in Silvassa received support from Navneet Foundation in the form of supplies of dictionaries, printer papers, notebooks, desks, and benches.

Teachers' Training Program


Navneet Foundation pioneered the Krutipatrika Training Program for teachers – a series of sessions that works towards equipping teachers with necessary competencies. The focus of training in Krutipatrika, meaning 'activity sheet' i.e. question paper, is activity-based teaching and evaluation. In 2018-19, the third year of implementation of these trainings were organised for teachers of

Standard IX and X.


Teachers from private and government aided schools serving class I to X were also trained on creative and participatory methods of teaching languages, mathematics, and other subjects. The trainings were conducted in 6 divisions of Maharashtra to benefit teachers from remote rural locations.

Master trainers' training programs were also organised in various regions prior to conducting training sessions. More than 5,879 teachers were trained through 108 training programs.

TRAININGS CONDUCTED

Educational Aid & Support

With a goal to motivate students, Navneet Foundation, along with their implementation partners, provided educational aid to girls and boys from junior KG to class XII. This year, 2,364 students benefitted from this scholarship program.

Navneet Foundation supported their implementation partners to provide scholarships for 107 students pursuing higher education. Also, 18 students who successfully secured seats in premier institutes for higher education were facilitated; thus, inspiring

the young and earnest to keep up their pursuit of quality education.

Through an Education Support Program, Navneet Foundation sponsored orphans and children of single parents by paying for their educational expenses. This year, 10 children were funded for education. These children live in a village home setup with housemothers, thus, providing a stable family structure, which in turn leads to a healthy environment for the child's development.

Programs / HEALTHCARE

The backbone of any community is a population that is both, physically and mentally healthy. Navneet Foundation, through various medical camps and hospitals in Maharashtra and Gujarat carry out many health interventions that provide treatments.

Nutrition

Navneet Foundation started Navneet Chaas Kendra in the year 1984 - an initiative that supplies *chaas* (buttermilk) to rural families. The centre distributes 1,500 litres of buttermilk everyday to 400 households. In 2019, 5,34,000 litres of buttermilk were distributed to families in Kutch.

Navneet Foundation supported a residential centre in Kutch for girls with special needs by providing food and kitchen equipment, which they helped set up as well, that benefitted 32 girls in all.

About 76 old age homes were supported by the Foundation in Gujarat by providing them with food.

Medical Aid

Navneet Foundation's mobile medical care program treated 2,349 patients in 5 villages close to Village Khaniwade near the Navneet factory.

Also, post surgery care was provided to 29 kidney transplant recipients. Kidney dialysis services were availed by 5,277 patients.

Services were provided during the 27th Navneet Mega Medical Camp in Kutch – organised by an implementation partner of the Foundation. The number of patients that received care was 5,550 and a total of 515 surgeries were performed during the mega medical camp.

With the help of other implementation partners, more than 1,743 patients were provided medical aid and 29 patients received post surgery care for kidney transplants in Gujarat and Maharashtra.

Redevelopment of the Health and Wellness Centre at Sayali Village was taken up by the Foundation. The centre is an initiative of the Department of Medical and Health Services, Silvassa, Dadra Nagar Haveli, and was inaugurated by Hon. Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi. The centre delivers quality services to patients and fulfils the health needs of the deprived in the region.

Programs / SPORTS

In line with its national spirit, Navneet Foundation believes than an investment in sports is a collective effort towards the growth and development of the nation. It develops skill, encourages team spirit, brings communities closer, and puts the nation on an international stage.

Sports Development

As a part of youth development, young players in cricket are groomed through participation in domestic matches and tournaments. More than 350 members (girls and boys) took part in tournaments organised thrice every week throughout the year. In each tournament, about 25 players participated. Life skills such as discipline, healthy food routines, time management, and environment sensitivity were provided as part of the training.

Nurturing Talent

Navneet Foundation has helped talented Indian sportspeople rediscover their full potential, especially those who can achieve excellence at national, international, and Olympic levels. The Foundation has been encouraging the upcoming

star of Indian table tennis, Diya Chitale for over three years.

Diya Chitale - International and National events of 2018-19

Diya Chitale has been receiving support from Navneet Foundation since 2016. She currently ranks No. 4 in the Under 15 Girls category. She won gold medals in the Serbia Junior Cadet Open and Junior & Youth National Championships. She won a silver medal in the Jordon Junior & Cadet Open in Cadet Girls (under 15) team event. She also won bronze medals in her first and second National Ranking Tournament, the Jordon Junior & Cadet Open in Cadet Girls (under 15) doubles event, in the Junior & Youth National Championships, and in the Senior National Championship.

Marathon

The Navneet Foundation has supported NGOs working in the fields of women's empowerment, education, and training for the specially-abled through marathons organised in Mumbai and Nashik.

Food & Shelter for Animals

Navneet Foundation has supported 390 *gaushalas* in Gujarat and Maharashtra, providing food, shelter, and medical care to animals in distress. Fodder and water was provided to 23,300 cattle and animals.

Programs / OTHER INITIATIVES

Navneet Foundation shares a desire to give back to society. To help the community grow and prosper, the Foundation actively participates in building affordable housing for the less fortunate, planting more trees, and distributing relief kits during natural disasters. The Foundation has slowly and steadily pushed boundaries and expanded horizons. As in previous years, this year too, the Foundation continues to immerse itself in wider social issues.

Tribal Welfare

Tribal development programs were supported in Dharampur and Kaprada, Valsad by Navneet Foundation. These programs included accessibility to paramedic services that were availed by 24,000 patients and economic empowerment for 5,072 women through the distribution of vegetable seeds and fruit plants for agricultural employment. The programs successfully reached out to 3,15,000 villagers in 289 villages through 7 centres.

Disaster Relief Intervention

During the 2018 Kerala floods, Navneet Foundation, along with their implementation partners, distributed food and utensil kits to 375 families. Kitchen utensils were provided to 2 tribal hostels. School and hostel fees were paid upfront for 97 students. To address menstrual hygiene of women and girls, 7,500 sanitary pads were distributed during this national disaster.

Affordable Housing

The need of the hour is safe and secure housing at reduced costs. Through an affordable housing scheme targeted towards the lesser privileged, Navneet Foundation constructed about 152 one-BHK houses equipped with all basic amenities and open spaces for recreation. The complex was designed keeping in mind the needs of rural families.

Environmental Development

In 2018-19, Navneet Foundation planted 320 trees adding to the green initiatives implemented across all its factories and surrounding communities.

Arts and Culture Development

Arts and culture education is known to strengthen problem-solving skills and enhance critical-thinking, apart from building academic excellence and real world skills. Which is why, Navneet Foundation supported a learning centre for arts and culture development in Gujarat. So far, the centre has provided opportunities to 100 students through their residential learning program.

A facility for children, young adults, and the elderly to explore art, culture, and sports activities is being constructed in Pune.


