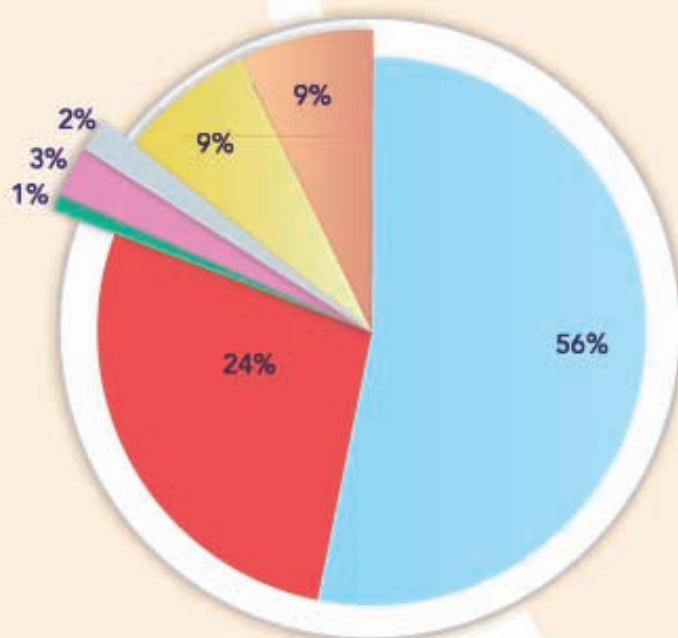

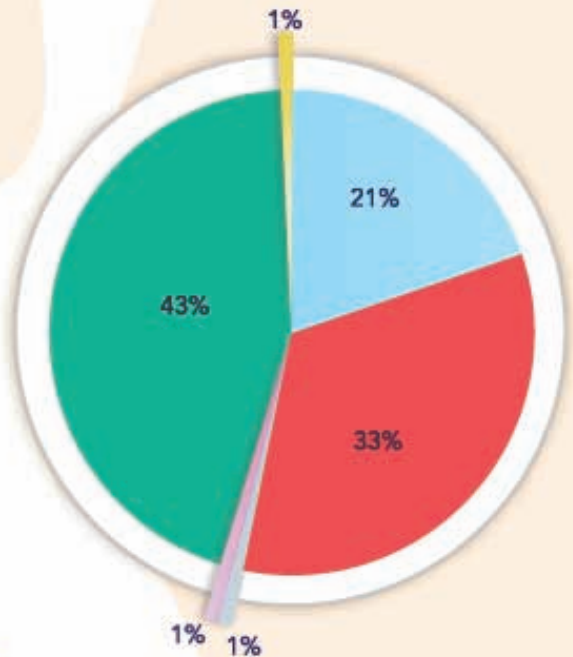

Navneet Foundation goes beyond financial aid, championing children by covering school, college, and institution fees. We bolster success through coaching, mentoring and counselling, safeguarding your children against academic dropout and paving their way for a lifelong achievement.

Enhancing Opportunities with Education

In a remarkable stride towards building brighter tomorrows, the Navneet Foundation has generously supported the education of **3,606** children this year. By providing them with this crucial opportunity, we paved the way for knowledge exploration and the attainment of a promising future. Moreover, in Maharashtra and Gujarat, we have further empowered **19,236** underprivileged children with essential educational resources like books and kits, ensuring they possess the necessary tools to thrive.

Development and Maintenance of Facilities for Education

Elevating Education: Navneet Foundation's Impactful Initiatives

Recognising the pivotal role of infrastructure in delivering quality education, Navneet Foundation is committed to enhance facilities that create an optimal learning environment for children. Through school infrastructure maintenance, **2,978 children** have gained access to effective educational spaces. Notably, hostel facilities have been provided to economically disadvantaged students pursuing education away from their hometowns, ensuring they have an uninterrupted educational journey. In Gujarat and Maharashtra, Navneet Foundation has gone an extra mile by establishing knowledge-packed libraries, acting as vibrant "knowledge banks" for children to explore and learn. These interventions have proven immensely beneficial, offering children opportunities for quality education and expansive exposure to knowledge.



By addressing the educational needs of underprivileged children in Gujarat's tribal region, a dedicated school provides holistic support, including education, boarding facilities, and **nutritious meals to over 454 students** in Grades VI to X. This initiative empowers these young learners to pursue their education against all odds.

In rural Gujarat, Navneet Foundation's impactful efforts continue with institution of a girl's college, creating a vital platform for youth to pursue higher education. So far, 57 girls have seized this opportunity by embracing education in a supportive environment crafted by the Navneet Foundation.

This year, Navneet Foundation has facilitated value education workshops for 250 children, emphasising the importance of upgrading skills in every professional's life. The power of experiential learning was demonstrated through a science exhibition involving 200 children.

In another initiative, Navneet Foundation has supported the development of a science, math, and language lab for **350** children in the slum community of suburban Mumbai. This endeavour has significantly improved their grasp of basic concepts and positively impacted their academic performance. HEALTHCARE AND MEDICAL SERVICES

Transforming Lives: Navneet Foundation's Commitment to Quality Healthcare

Navneet Foundation firmly believes that quality healthcare is a fundamental right, accessible to all. In Gujarat and Maharashtra, underprivileged individuals are empowered with access to best medical services at affordable rates, bridging the gap in healthcare services.





Throughout the year, efforts were made to alleviate the burden faced by marginalised patients, providing medical aid, and covering treatment expenses.

A remarkable 6,347 underprivileged patients received support for their medical treatments and surgeries, while

30 families were safeguarded with medical insurance coverage during times of crisis.

Navneet Foundation's steadfast dedication to healthcare has emerged as a pivotal focus, positively impacting the lives of underprivileged patients and providing essential dialysis treatments to individuals through free dialysis sessions. Additionally underprivileged patients accessed diagnosis and treatment services through the low-cost, high-quality healthcare infrastructure facilitated by Navneet Foundation.

In a significant move, a major municipal hospital in Mumbai underwent a transformative makeover, involving the renovation and development of patient and doctor quarters, as well as museum and conference spaces. This upgrade ensured that doctors attending to underprivileged patients could recover in clean, hygienic, and comfortable surroundings after complex surgeries. With improved surgical tables and donated ventilators, the hospital efficiently treated 645 patients. We firmly believe in the impact of enhanced healthcare facilities and state-of-the-art medical equipment in delivering exceptional services. Through the enhancement of hospital infrastructure, including doctor facilities, conference spaces, and patient rooms, we have extended access to quality healthcare to 3,900 patients in Gujarat and Maharashtra.





These improvements have also enabled Navneet Foundation to reach 19,683 underprivileged individuals, ensuring their connection to advanced medical facilities. Moreover, our dedication extends to remote tribal communities, where our trained village volunteers and medical experts have provided essential first-aid services to 5,490 people. In rural Maharashtra, the introduction of a delivery table at a Primary Health Centre has significantly improved maternity services, befitting 180 women in need. In collaboration, we persist in empowering communities by expanding healthcare infrastructure and changing lives.



Additionally, our commitment extends to remote tribal communities, **where 5,490 individuals have received vital first-aid services through our trained village volunteers and medical professionals.** Together, we continue to empower communities by developing healthcare infrastructure and transforming lives.

Reaching out for better accessibility (Transforming Lives through Mega Medical Camps):


Medical camps serve as an invaluable platform, bringing comprehensive healthcare to the underprivileged under one roof. The mega camps have touched the lives of over **2,585** patients, providing essential diagnostic services, medical treatments, and life-changing surgeries.

Beyond immediate medical assistance, these camps foster community awareness about healthcare and the pursuit of a healthy lifestyle. Recognizing the importance of mental health, our intervention extends to the villages, where over 1,000 patients have received diagnosis and treatment for psychiatric conditions. Together, we strive to make a positive impact on the physical and mental well-being of those in need, nurturing healthier and happier lives.

We believe that access to healthcare is a fundamental right, and through this support we strive to uplift individuals facing renal challenges, offering them a ray of hope and renewed vitality.

Recognizing that food is not just sustenance but a vital necessity, we have extended our reach to **3,700** underprivileged individuals, ensuring their basic needs are fulfilled. By providing grocery kits, we aim to alleviate hunger and nourish communities in need, fostering strength and resilience. Additionally, we have extended this support to children in rural Maharashtra, offering nourishing midday meals that serve as a beacon of hope and vitality for their bright futures.

Together, we embrace the power of compassion, healthcare, and nourishment to uplift lives and create a brighter tomorrow for those who need it the most.



In the tribal areas of Uttar Pradesh and Gujarat, a dedicated medical camp brought hope to rural communities facing limited access to ophthalmology services by facilitating over **120 critical eye surgeries**, which have supported and transformed the lives of individuals, providing newfound clarity and restoring their sight. Furthermore, Navneet Foundation's commitment extended to supporting **377 children with food and meals** at a shelter for girls with special needs in Kachchh, Gujarat. Early intervention camps conducted in Kachchh identified the needs of children at an early age, allowing tailored strategies and therapies to enhance their nutritional development. In their unwavering pursuit of holistic well-being, Navneet Foundation's initiatives continue to empower communities, providing a brighter and healthier future for all.

In the fight against tuberculosis, Navneet Foundation goes beyond medical treatment, recognizing the importance of nourishment. We have provided specially crafted food kits annually to 1200 TB patients across BMC health posts, featuring nutritious ingredients like Nachni flour, jowar flour, bajra flour and more. These kits have shown remarkable results, improving the health and recovery of underprivileged TB patients living in slums of Mumbai. This initiative aligns with the "National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme" (NTEP) and contributes to the fulfillment of Sustainable Development Goals.

Furthermore, Navneet Foundation extends its compassionate support to the visually impaired community, **supplying essential grocery kits to 3,500 individuals**. Together, we strive to make a lasting impact on the health and well-being of underprivileged communities, taking one nourishing step at a time.

She was suffering from TB and was very afraid. But after receiving nutritional kits and sanitiser, she was free from TB. Additionally, she did not have any side effects from the medicines and was also feeling stronger than before.

With a commitment to their well-being, we provide vital support, including nourishing fodder, essential medicines, and safe shelter for these magnificent living beings.



Our efforts go beyond mere sustenance as we open our hearts and homes to visually impaired, physically impaired and elderly animals, offering them a sanctuary they can call their own. At these shelters, skilled veterinarians perform surgeries to heal animals afflicted with tumours, remove plastic from the stomach of stray animals, rectify limb deformities, and address a range of ailments, ensuring their health and happiness. With every act of kindness, we contribute to the betterment of our animal friends, fostering a world where compassion reigns and every creature finds solace and care.



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Building Bridges: Navneet Foundation's Empowering Haven for Underprivileged Students

In a feat of transformation, we have supported the creation of a sprawling **37,500 sq. ft.** hostel facility in Mumbai.

This haven embraces underprivileged students from distant districts and states, offering them more than just a roof over their heads. Within these walls, they find a nurturing environment complete with comfortable accommodations, delectable meals and dedicated study rooms, empowering them to thrive academically. But it doesn't stop there. This remarkable establishment goes beyond education, serving as a vibrant community hub. A captivating community hall stands tall, fostering a vibrant platform for the promotion of art and culture among local residents.

To date, this dynamic space has welcomed and uplifted **4,272** community members, enriching lives with shared experiences.

Throughout the year, the foundation extended its support to self-help groups engaged in income generation and infrastructure development initiatives. By embracing activities such as mushroom farming and agarbatti making, these programmes empowered **2,500** families, leading to remarkable transformations in their lives. Emphasising self-dependence and empowerment, the company's engagement with self-help groups and microcredit initiatives have positively impacted over **10,000** individuals, elevating their socio-economic circumstances. Another **12,200** Mahila Mandals, comprising an impressive count of **131,700** resilient women, have witnessed a remarkable improvement in their socio-economic standing, marking a profound transformation in their lives through income generation programmes.



Throughout the year, spirited encounters with 900 Yuvati Baithaks (gatherings of young women) set the stage for captivating discussions, aimed at raising awareness about the harmful effects of alcohol and substance abuse. These engaging sessions adeptly instilled the value of education in the minds of our aspiring young girls, empowering them with impressive problem-solving skills.

A comprehensive training programme on organic farming and innovative agricultural techniques was enthusiastically embraced by 230 farmers, augmenting their knowledge and expertise in farming pursuits. Embarking on an empowering journey, we bestowed sewing machines upon seven women, opening up new avenues for their income generation. Additionally, 25 underprivileged women received home appliances to enhance their daily lives, easing their everyday tasks and helping them generate income from home.



Recognising the pressing need for legal assistance within underprivileged communities, we supported 100 legal professionals in honing their skills through dynamic workshops and training sessions, equipping them with formidable skill-sets.

Demonstrating our compassion, a dedicated ambulance service was provided to the community, effectively addressing 300 medical emergencies, and bridging the gap in essential healthcare services. In the remote villages of Virar taluka, families previously deprived of electricity due to limited income sources were provided with solar lights, illuminating their homes, and bringing hope amidst the darkness.

ENVIRONMENTAL DEVELOPMENT

Revitalising Water Resources and Promoting Environmental Care

Kachchh, Gujarat, is a water-deficient region. Initiatives were undertaken to revive water bodies in a village in Mandvi. The villages in this region have been frequently affected by droughts and heavily rely on groundwater resources for agriculture and domestic use. In this village, irrigation and groundwater recharge efforts were implemented, benefiting 161 families and over **1,000** individuals. The groundwater capacity has witnessed a remarkable increase of 17 percent. The rejuvenation work of 21 structures in these villages, including on Rukmavati river, has boosted the cumulative water capacity by 14 percent. Significant improvements have been observed in water quality, with a TDS difference of -421. Desilting activities have aided 483 farmer families, leading to enhanced farm yields and improved accessibility to resources for approximately **3,000** individuals.





To promote environmental care, tree plantation drives were organised in villages where community members planted more than **153** trees. Engaging children in environmental stewardship, **250** young individuals were provided with plant saplings, fostering their involvement in nurturing green resources within their communities.

More than 410 aspiring young cricketers, including 217 talented girls, have undergone comprehensive training, igniting their passion for the sport. These enthusiastic youth have fearlessly taken on 78 challenging matches, showcasing their skills across states and their hometowns, emerging victorious in an impressive 37 encounters. Notable triumphs abound as two exceptional girls secured spots in the prestigious under-15 team, while another accomplished player earned a well-deserved place in the under-19 squad, proudly representing the esteemed Mumbai Cricket Association. Additionally, five talented girls achieved remarkable success in cricket scoring exams, while two demonstrated their expertise by clearing the umpiring examination conducted by the Mumbai Cricket Association. Fostering a spirit of camaraderie and competitive spirit, the Navneet Cricket Cup, a highly anticipated annual event, united **1,924** enthusiastic players from diverse backgrounds, including passionate men, women, and revered senior citizens, across both rural and urban settings.



Amidst these inspiring accomplishments, let us celebrate the extraordinary journey of 13-year-old Naishaa Bhatoye, **Badminton Player** who defied all odds and became the sole player to represent Maharashtra in all three age groups: under-15, under-17, and under-19. Overcoming the challenges posed by the pandemic, Naishaa's unwavering determination and perseverance have propelled her towards unmatched success in her game.

Furthermore, Diya Chitale, the under-17 **Tennis Champion**, is backed for her professional coaching and training. Her training has paid off as she won a bronze medal in the U19 Singles WTT Youth Star Contender in Slovenia and a gold medal in the U19 Singles WTT Youth Star Contender in Lima. Her current focus is on the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, which serves as a crucial milestone towards her success in the sport.

While Aum Jangla, an accomplished international **Skating Champion**, continues to thrive with continuous backing in her training and participation in international tournaments.

Lastly, Hardik Sane, an indomitable Adventurer, receives support for his awe-inspiring **expedition to Mount Everest**. These remarkable tales of ambition, triumph and unwavering support embody our commitment to nurturing sporting talent and fostering a culture of achievement.

Amidst the global surge in appreciation for Indian art and culture, the relentless wave of Western influence threatens to overshadow indigenous traditions. In response, dedicated efforts are underway to safeguard the vibrant Kachchhi folk music and its rich cultural heritage, not only providing financial and social support to music artists, but also reigniting pride in their traditional art forms.

Following a prolonged absence due to a devastating earthquake, the revered gathering known as Reyan triumphantly returned to the region. Throughout the year, 48 talented artists and musicians mesmerized audiences with captivating performances of Kachchhi folk music. This soul-stirring repertoire included enchanting Kaafi (Sufi music), evocative folk songs, devotional bhajans and the timeless melodies of traditional instruments like Jodiya, Pava, and Morchang.



The resounding success of these events witnessed the enthusiastic participation of over 1,000 individuals, fostering a deeper connection to their cultural heritage and nurturing a renewed appreciation for their musical traditions.

Moreover, in a momentous move to preserve this musical legacy, the establishment of Riyaaz Shala, a folk music school in Khari village, has created an invaluable platform for the younger generation to learn, cherish, and immerse themselves in the profound artistry of Kachchhi folk music and cultural expressions. This year, 21 passionate individuals have eagerly enrolled, ensuring the timeless wisdom and artistry of their heritage are passed down to future generations. Recognizing the importance of holistic development, a special Raksha Bandhan function was thoughtfully arranged for 250 visually impaired girls, nurturing their overall growth and well-being. Furthermore, cultural activities have become a binding force, uniting 150 spirited youth, and fostering stronger community ties while celebrating the vibrant tapestry of their cultural heritage.
